POSITION REQUIREMENTS:

- Must have completed new members classes (Discovering Jacob's Well)
- Must have completed level 2 discipleship classes (A Growing Life)
- Must be an example of a growing Christian as outlined in Discipleship lessons (Levels 1-2)
- Must be faithful in attendance to church services and a small group
- Must be dependable

JOB DESCRIPTIONS & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Faithfully Pray. As disciples, we are commanded to not only to pray for our needs but for the needs of others. Prayer is important and life changing. Philippians 4:6 tells us: *Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything!*
- Discretion: Please keep prayer requests within the church family



- Check emails at least twice a day for new or urgent prayer requests
- Develop a system for remembering to pray - perhaps using a notebook or prayer journal
- Pray with others during worship service (during prayer slot and alter call)
- Regularly participate in in-person prayer meetings
- SHARE PRAISE! Let the prayer team know when God has graciously answered our prayers

TIME REQUIREMENT:

- Take needs to the Lord
 - Immediately: as urgent requests arise
 - Often/Daily: Chronic needs
- 1 hour quarterly, in-person, prayer meeting
- Be intentional, schedule a time for prayer
