POSITION REQUIREMENTS:

- Must have completed new members classes (Discovering Jacob's Well)
- Must have completed level 3 discipleship classes (A Maturing Life)
- Must be an example of mature Christianity as outlined in Discipleship lessons (Levels 1-3)
- Must give consistently to Tithes, Offering, and Missions (TOM)
- Must be faithful in attendance to church services and a small group
- Must be dependable

JOB DESCRIPTIONS & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Exemplify character, integrity, and leadership in a manner consistent with the Word
- Orient, train, and oversee team members
- Receive and communicate prayer requests from members, extended church family, and from those online
- Share prayer requests and praise reports in a timely fashion



- Use discretion in sharing pertinent details of requests with the Prayer Team
- Share newsletters from our missionaries with the Prayer Team and the church on a weekly basis
- Faithfully pray
- Solicit cards and calls of support when appropriate
- Order flowers for members when there has been a death as well as for appropriate family members
- Lead prayer during the Sunday worship service
- Pray with others during worship service (during prayer slot and alter call)
- Conduct quarterly in-person prayer meetings
- Intentionally and strategically teach about prayer (via email, share videos, during quarterly prayer meetings, etc.)
- Provide ongoing constructive communication with team members and pastoral team lead

TIME REQUIREMENT:

- Take needs to the Lord
 - Immediately: as urgent requests arise
 - Often/Daily: Chronic needs
- 1 hour quarterly, in-person, prayer meeting
- Be intentional, schedule a time for prayer
