#### **POSITION REQUIREMENTS:**

- Must have completed new members classes (Discovering Jacob's Well)
- Must have completed level 3 discipleship classes (A Maturing Life)
- Must be an example of mature Christianity as outlined in Discipleship lessons (Levels 1-3)
- Must give consistently to Tithes, Offering, and Missions (TOM)
- Must be faithful in attendance to church services and a small group
- Must be dependable
- Basic knowledge of cleaning techniques and product usage
- Basic knowledge computer software and hardware

## **JOB DESCRIPTIONS & RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Exemplify character, integrity, and leadership in a manner consistent with the Word
- Orient, train, and oversee team members
- Coordinate and schedule team members
- Facilitate routine and as needed maintenance with vendors (i.e. HVAC and pest control)
- Assess and maintain supply inventory (cleaning tools and products, facilities supplies)
- Facilitate equipment maintenance (i.e., vacuum cleaner)
- Ensure internal property is consistently clean and well maintained

- Facilitate the maintenance of the exterior property including grass, flower beds, trees, leaves, snow, ice, trash pick-up and removal
- Provide ongoing constructive communication with team members and pastoral team lead

### TIME REQUIREMENT:

- Scheduling Staff: One to three hours per quarter
- Maintenance Appointments: Approximately two hours per quarter
- Training: Two hours per quarter or more frequently to onboard new members

# **TEAM REQUIREMENT:**

- Post service: Approximately 1 hour weekly following each service
- Weekday (upstairs): Approximately 1 hour weekly
- Post Potlucks/Repasts (Fellowship Hall bathrooms): 45 minutes
- Special Events and Services: As required
- Comprehensive cleaning, ongoing development, and training: Approximately two hours per quarter
- Seasonal outdoor clean-up: Approximately 2 hours, twice a year.
